

# **Block and Tackle**

Block and Tackle is a break from the conventional form of debating. Here, you need to speak both for and against the motion. You start off speaking for the motion and when the moderator says 'block' you need to reverse your motion, and 'tackle' would mean to return to your original motion.

A participant is given any random topic and instantly has to speak, "for or against" the topic. In a duration of 5 minutes whenever the judge commands 'switch', the speaker will have to toggle between 'for' and 'against' multiple times thereby contradicting the previous statements.

# **RULES**:

- Registration is mandatory.
- The required details should be filled with utmost care. once registered, changing the information will not be entertained.
- By registering for the event, you accept that the organizer's decision will be final and binding. No disputes shall be entertained at the later date.

# Debugging

Here the participants will be given several questions along with an explanation about what the code is expected to do. A solution will be provided with the problem description but the given solution will have several compilation (syntax and semantic), Runtime, Linker, Logical errors. The code will be on Algorithms, C, and Python. The participants are expected to fix the bug in the code such that it should pass all the test cases tested by us.

# **TERMS AND CONDITIONS:**

1. Read the given description carefully and understand the problem.

2. Analyze the code given in the problem and find bugs in these codes.

3. The given code can be copied and compiled in an online compiler.Eg. Programiz, Online GDB.

# **RULES**:

1. Languages accepted for this contest are C and Python.

2. The maximum time limit for each program is 5 minutes.

3. The one who solves the maximum number of programs in a short period of time will be considered.

4. Since, it is a debugging contest; you will be provided a bug solution. Please see that you must adhere to the problem code provided, make changes only when necessary.

5. Submissions in any other languages will not be considered.

6. Each program will be tested based on critical test data.

7. Your submission would be required to pass certain test cases: that is, it should provide the Correct output for the given input.

8. Make sure other participants don't have access to your code. In case you are using another Online coding environment, you are responsible for the privacy of your code.

9. Please refrain from discussing strategy during the contest.

10. Referring Books or any other websites for solution of the code given or for any other related

Concepts during the contest will not be encouraged.

11. The participants are only allowed to use only the standard online compilers discussed above for compilation of the code given.

12. Using smartphones, tablets and any other smart electronic gadgets like Bluetooth, air pods will not be encouraged inside the premises where the event occurs.
