Every project is uniquely identified by assigning Project Id based on SDG. The various projects are based on Immunization, Malnourished children, Protection from disease and disability, cognitive development, clean water and sanitization, Affordable and environmentally friendly clean energy.

- Providing Financial assistance for applying patent rights for further recognition
