A report on the feedback on curriculum

The feedback on the curriculum was collected from the students, teachers, alumni and employees. The feedback was collected on a 5 point scale on 10 important criteria such as

- Improving professional competency, practical exposure
- Satisfying industry requirement, customers
- Suitability to the current industry requirements
- Enabling employment opportunities, life skills
- Promoting ethics, self-discipline, value system

From the feedback obtained for the year 2019-2020, Alumni feel that the practical exposure needs to be improved and more current technologies are to be included. The Employers feedback also reflected the same point. Hence the report was placed into the agenda of the forthcoming GC meeting for information and approval for further proceedings. Since the Institution acquired Autonomous status during the year 2020-2021, syllabus revisions were carried out with adequate inputs from industry personnel and reputed academic experts.

Actions taken by the Institution:

- The gap between the industry requirements and the curriculum is bridged by adding certificate courses and value added programs.
- The students are encouraged to undergo these programmes and also for self-learning by attending online courses in platforms such as NPTEL, Coursera, EDX
- Frequent organization of seminars, workshops, conferences and symposia enable the students to know the current technological trends and get inputs from industry partners and also from other academic institutions
- The introduction of the courses are recommended and approved by the Advisory boards of the departments.
- These points are discussed in the Board of Studies and Academic Council meetings by the teachers who participate in the same.
