1. Now Therefore this MoU Witness as Under

SEC and SIRD &PR, Tamil Nadu will work together and involve themselves for undertaking activities and programmes in the following domain areas.

- 1.2. Field Work/Internship both short term and long term for the students of SEC including awareness/Rights & responsibilities at SIRD &PR.
- 1.3. Strengthening the Grama Panchayats to operate digitally.
- 1.4. Optimizing the judicious use of local resources by establishing natural resource governance.
- 1.5. Prioritizing the access to enjoy the basic amenities for the welfare of the population.
- 1.6. Bringing the realization of having the empowered self-governance.
- 1.7. Executing Village Adoption Programme and Out-reach Programme for Model Village.
- 1.8. Ensuring good health and quality education as predominant objectives.
- 1.9. Organizing Exhibitions/Meetings and Melas jointly by SEC and SIRD &PR.
- 1.10. Empowering with information exclusively to get benefited from the government offering schemes.
- 1.11. Networking with Institutions working for Rural Development & Panchayat Raj.
- 1.12. Creating pivotal knowledge of solid and liquid waste management.
- 1.13. Establishing Entrepreneurship, Skill development, innovation and incubation in the areas of rural development & Engineering Sector.
- 1.14. Documentation of case studies on Fair/Best practices and its Dissemination.
- 1.15. Bringing consistent social auditing.
- 1.16. Implementing suitable and fitting SDGs with a three-year plan.

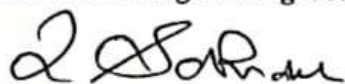

2. Both Institutions shall agree upon the following
 - 2.1. Preparing and finalizing an Annual Action Plan
 - 2.2. Contribution in terms of financial resources, human resources, physical infrastructure facilities and any other resources shall mutually be decided on a case to case basis.
 - 2.3. The rates applicable for Government Institutions towards Institutional Fee/ Consultancy Charges/ Faculty cost/ logistics/ GST/ Income Tax and other eligible expenditure may be charged by both Institutions on mutual consent on a case to case basis.
3. **COORDINATION:** Senior Level Representative for each Institution shall be nominated as Nodal Officer for facilitating the implementation of Annual Action Plans properly as planned.
4. **AMENDMENT:** This MoU may be amended, from time to time depending on the need, on mutual agreement.
5. **TERMINATION CLAUSE:** Any Party may terminate the Agreement with three (3) months of advance notice in writing, unless an earlier termination is mutually agreed upon.
6. **DISPUTE RESOLUTION:** Disputes, if any relating to this MOU shall be settled through mutual negotiations between the Parties. Any appeal will vest with a committee consisting of Additional Chief Secretary/Director General (Training) and the Principal of SEC.
7. **DURATION of MoU:** This Agreement is valid for five (5) years from the effective date.
8. **EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Agreement becomes effective from the date of signing of this MoU.

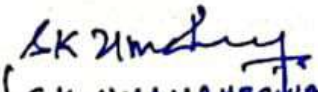

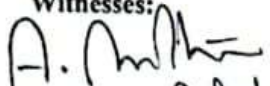
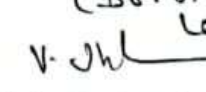
